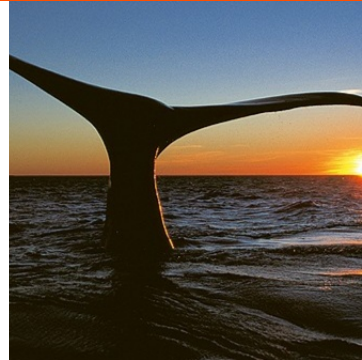


# Adventure Africa Motorcycle Tours

## CAPE TOWN TO CAPE AGULHAS



We start our ride nice and early from central Cape Town and head East making our way through the ancient Cape Fold mountains.

Part of our route is the beautiful coastal road known as Clarence Drive, it was built by Italian POW's during WW2. We will stop in Hermanus for a coffee and see if there are any Southern Right Wales in Walker Bay. They frequent these coastal waters between June and December. Hermanus is a popular holiday/fishing town and a Whale watching paradise about 120km South East from Cape Town.

After our stopover in town, we head out further South East until we reach Cape Agulhas, the Southernmost tip of Africa. Here we'll see the meeting place of the Great Atlantic & Indian oceans and the 2nd oldest Lighthouse in South Africa dating back to 1848. After our visit, we leave the Agulhas bank behind and head inland through the Overberg region.

This region is known for it's Barley, Canola and Sheep farming and this makes for a very scenic ride through the countryside. Expect to see sheer natural beauty on this ride. Mountains, coastline, Cape fynbos Flora, rolling hills, awesome wildlife, friendly people and good food!
